



## **Student Law Clerk**

The Legal Aid Society of San Mateo County provides free civil legal services to low-income residents of San Mateo County. We have an immediate opening for a student law clerk to assist attorneys working at Legal Aid's Health Consumer Center. The Health Consumer Center is part of a statewide coalition of health care advocates working on health law issues that affect low-income Californians. Attorneys at the Health Consumer Center provide direct client services and engage in policy work. The law clerk will be actively involved in a variety of projects including legal research and writing, interviewing clients, outreach, and working on health policy issues affecting our clients. Familiarity or experience working with public health programs such as Medi-Cal and Medicare is helpful though not required.

Candidates must be 2Ls or 3Ls. Proficiency in Spanish is strongly encouraged. 2Ls interested in pursuing a post-graduate fellowship are particularly encouraged to apply as there is the possibility of developing a post-graduate fellowship project at Legal Aid. The clerkship is an unpaid position. We require a commitment of at least 10 hours per week. Our office is walking distance to Caltrain and there is ample free street parking nearby.
