

## Health Consumer Center (HCC): COVID-19 Fast Facts for Community Members

Last updated: June 25, 2021

- Every Californian age 12 and up is now eligible for free COVID-19 vaccination. To get vaccinated, sign up at <u>myturn.ca.gov</u> or call (833) 422-4255.
- COVID-19 testing is free for all Californians, even those with no health insurance. To get tested, contact your health services provider or visit: <u>www.smcgov.org/testing</u>
- COVID-19 treatment is free for both people with no health insurance and people with private insurance that does not cover COVID-19 treatment. Medi-Cal beneficiaries are eligible for free COVID-19 treatment even if they usually have a share of cost.
- COVID-19 vaccines, testing, and treatment will not count under the "Public Charge" rule.
  Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) will not carry out enforcement operations at or near health facilities during the COVID-19 crisis except in the most extraordinary of circumstances.
- Medi-Cal will not take negative actions until the end of the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency.
- Medi-Cal patients without a health plan and uninsured Californians may call the state's 24/7 "Medi-Nurse" line (1-877-409-9052) about COVID-19 concerns or general medical issues.
- In response to the COVID-19 crisis, Covered California has re-opened enrollment until the end of 2021 and is offering increased financial assistance. Visit: <u>www.coveredca.com/get-started</u>
- Seniors who are struggling to afford food should call San Mateo County Health's Aging and Adult Services helpline at (800) 675-8437 for information on nutrition assistance.
